The Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Centre (SMRCC) is seeking a full time Locum Medical Oncologist for 3 months starting May 1, 2017. SMRCC opened in June 2012, providing state-of-the-art care to residents living in Simcoe Muskoka. The systemic therapy team at SMRCC consists of 11 Medical Oncologists (full time and part time) who provide consultative services for more than 2500 new patients annually. The centre includes a 34-chair chemotherapy suite, two large outpatient clinics, two level IV satellite chemotherapy clinics, and three linear accelerators with provision for three additional radiation treatment machines in the future. SMRCC is committed to patient safety and experience, utilizing new technology to provide high quality care including an integrated oncology information system and an intelligent chemotherapy preparation system (RIVA, Robotic IV Automation). In addition, the SMRCC offers comprehensive services to the region including prevention, screening, surgical oncology, supportive care and clinical research programs for patients and their families.
